FACTS	WHAT DOES OUR GROUP OF AFFILIATED COMPANIES DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect, and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include, but is not limited to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Account balances and transaction history. ❖ Investment experience and assets. ❖ Information we receive from you on applications or other forms including, but not limited to, your social security number or taxpayer identification number, home address and email address. ❖ Information about your transactions with us, our affiliates, or others.
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; whether or not we share your information; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What We Do	
How do we protect your personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we maintain administrative, technical, and physical safeguards that comply with federal law. These measures include safeguards designed to protect information, detect and respond to unauthorized access or use, and support recovery from such events. We restrict access to personal information to employees, representatives, agents, and authorized service providers who require such access to perform their duties, as permitted by law.
How do we collect your personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Open an account or give us your income information. ❖ Seek advice about your investments or tell us about your portfolio. ❖ Invest, deposit, or withdraw money. We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
Why can't you limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness. ❖ Affiliates from using your information to market to you. ❖ Sharing for non-affiliates to market to you. State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.
What happens when you limit sharing for an account you hold jointly?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.
Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. Our affiliates include the member companies of Savile Capital Group LLC.
Non-affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.
Do Not Call Policy	
This notice is the Do Not Call Policy of the member companies of Savile Capital Group under the Telephone Consumer Protection Act. We do not solicit via phone numbers listed on the state or federal Do Not Call lists, unless the law permits. Consumers who ask not to receive telephone solicitations from us will be placed on the Do Not Call list and will not be called in any future solicitations.	
Other Important Information	
Our relationship with you is one of our most important assets. We recognize that you have entrusted us with your private financial information, and we will do our utmost to maintain this trust.	
Information Security Incidents: In the event of unauthorized access to sensitive personal information, we maintain procedures designed to respond to such incidents and, where required by law, to notify affected individuals.	
Nevada residents: We are providing you with this notice pursuant to state law. You may be placed on our internal Do Not Call List by following the directions in the "To limit our sharing" section. Vermont residents: In accordance with Vermont law, we will not share information we collect about Vermont residents with companies outside of our corporate family, except as permitted by law, such as with your consent, to service your accounts or to other financial institutions with which we have joint marketing agreements. We will not share information about your creditworthiness within our corporate family except with your authorization or consent, but we may share information about our transactions or experiences with you within our corporate family without your consent.	
California residents: If you are a California resident and we share information with affiliates, or if we have entered into joint marketing agreements with non-affiliated financial companies, we have separately mailed you a California Privacy Notice. If you do not want us to share your information with such companies, please let us know by simply calling the telephone number provided or completing the reply form contained in the California Privacy Notice and mailing it to the address provided. If you are a new customer, we can begin sharing your information 45 days from the date we sent this notice.
